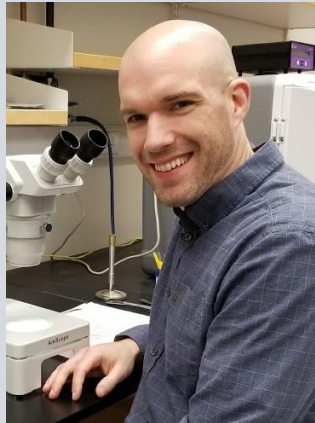

Our research focuses on how organisms perceive and response to stress, in the context of aging. In this seminar, I will present data on mechanisms regulating dietary restriction, including food perception, drugs that extend lifespan and mimic dietary restriction, and an enzyme that promotes longevity by modifying metabolism. Together, the seminar will touch upon neurobiology, metabolism, and stress response, each in the context of aging.
